In die meisies afdeling (13–15 jaar) het Silara van der Merwe 'n eerste plek met tuimel behaal en 'n tweede plek in die balkie. Sinze Oosthuizen het in die meisies 12 jaar-afdeling, eerste in die balkie- en tweede in trampolien-kompetisie geëindig.

Ronin van der Merwe was een van twee seuns wat aan die kompetisie deelgeneem het. Hy het in die 10 jaar-seunsafdeling, eerste geëindig in die trampolien en tweede met balkie. Nicardo van den Berg het die ander seun en het in dieselfde ouderdomsgroep, tweede geëindig met trampolien en derde met balkie.

Hulle afrigter, Amoné Swart het aan *Die Pos* gesê sy is baie trots op hierdie groep gimnaste. "Ons is 'n nuwe klub en ons toerusting is maar

karig, maar dit wat ons op kompetisies bereik spreek boekdele van die deursettingsvermoë en talent van ons gimnaste," het sy gesê.

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Die talentvolle oud-leerder van die Hoërskool Nylstroom in Modimolle, Tariso Nkosi (19), het onlangs geskiedenis gemaak op die atletiekbaan. Sy het Suid-Afrika op indrukwekkende wyse verteenwoordig tydens die Confederation of African Athletes (CAA) Jeug- en Junior-kampioenskap, wat van 16 tot 20 Julie in Nigerië gehou is.

Nkosi het met toewyding en vasberadenheid deelgeneem aan die hoogspring en met 'n sprong van 1,70 m die goue medalje verower.

"n Prestasie wat haar nie net eerste op die podium geplaas het nie, maar ook haar naam in die atletiekwêreld se rekordboeke opskryf het.

Die pad na Nigerië was egter nie maklik nie. Om te kwalifiseer vir die internasionale kampioenskap, moes Nkosi eers deur die plaaslike en nasionale vlakke bewys sy is op wêreldkampioen standaard.

Sy het aanvanklik aan die Sentraal Gauteng Atletiekklub se byeenkoms deelgeneem, waar sy 'n eerste plek behaal het. Dit het haar plek verseker om van 27 tot 29 Maart aan Atletiek Suid-Afrika (ASA) se Nasionale Kampioenskap, deel te neem. Weereens het sy haar teenstaanders in die stof laat byt en het sy die goue medalje verower. Haar plek in die SA-span vir die byeenkoms in Nigerië was verseker.

"Ek is verheug om die goue medalje in Nigerië te wen. Dit was 'n ongelooflike ervaring om Suid-Afrika te verteenwoordig en myself te dryf om my beste te lewer," vertel 'n opgewonde Nkosi aan *Die Pos*.

Nkosi se prestasie het nie net haar land in glorie gehul nie, maar het ook groot trots en bewondering vir haar alma mater, Hoërskool Nylstroom, meegebring.

Sy dien as 'n inspirasie vir talle jong atlete in Limpopo en bewys dat talent, gekombineer met ywer en harde werk, werklik tot internasionale hoogtes kan lei.

APPLICANT: Department of Land Reform & Rural Development

PROJECT NAME: The proposed construction of two (2) trafficable stormwater bridge structures in Rust de Winter within the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality, Gauteng Province.

PROPOSED ACTIVITY: The Department of Land Reform & Rural Development proposes to construct two (2) trafficable stormwater bridge structures in Rust de Winter within the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality, Gauteng Province. There are two stream crossing positions that were identified as crossings that require urgent attention.

The existing causeways are meant to allow access in shallow flow conditions. Access is difficult and in certain cases, impossible for motorists and pedestrians to cross the causeways. These circumstances create a risky situation for residents in these areas during heavy rainy seasons.

LOCATION OF BRIDGES: Bridge one (1) will be located at: 25°15'10.10"S & 28°40'15.77"E; and Bridge two (2) will be located at: 25°15'28.23"S & 28°40'4.31"E

LEGISLATION: In terms of Sections 24(2) and 24D of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended, read with the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of GNR 324 to 327 (2017), the following listed activities are being applied for: GNR 327, Activity 12 & 19 and GN R 324 Activities 12 and 14. A Water Use Licence is also required in terms of the National Water Act (Act No. 36 of 1998) as per Section 21 a, c and i water uses.
