REQUIREMENTS: The candidate should hold as minimum, three-year Bachelor Degree or National Diploma with majors in Accounting > Economics, or Finance including either Risk Management and/or Auditing, among other. The intern will sign an internship agreement which is in addition to the employment contract. The effect of the agreement is to ensure commitment to the programme which require, amongst other, full participation in the educational and workplace assignments and observance of policies and procedures.
