6. All supplementary / compulsory forms contained in the bid document must be completed and signed in full.
7. Bidders must attach three (3) year audited Financial Statements.
8. Bidders must attach Certified or Original BBBEE Verification Certificate, in case of Joint Venture bidders must submit a consolidated BBBEE Score card.
